- Aloe Vera may also be applied to calm and heal the tissues of the rectum.
- For more serious cases, a combination of natural and procedures may be necessary.

## Stapled Hemorrhoidectomy

The procedure removes a ring of tissue from the anal canal. The cutting of the tissue cuts the hemorrhoids off the blood flow and as a result they shrink. Then, the cells ring is secured with staples which support the tissue in place.

- Too much muscle tissue is drawn, this can result in damage to the rectal wall.
- This may lead to inflammation or infection.
- The internal sphincter muscle tissue may be damaged.
- The result may be a long-term or a short-term dysfunction such as severe pain and incontinence.

Treatment for hemorrhoid is a relatively simple surgery that involves stopping the blood flow to the main artery that supplies blood to the inflamed vein. Doctors may choose to treat the condition with topical creams and creams if detected early; or suggest procedures such as Doppler filigation, hemorrhoidectomy, or sclerotherapy depending on the severity of the problem and signs.

## After Surgery

After the procedure you will be taken to a rest area to recover from the anesthesia. Perhaps you may need to remain in hospital for the night or just leave the hospital the same day. The doctor will prescribe you pain-alleviating medication for the surgery wound and laxatives to ease bowel movement.

Hemorrhoids are of two types: External hemorrhoids which occur outside the rectum and underneath the anus; and internal hemorrhoids that take place in the anal canal. Internal hemorrhoids often go undetected, as there are no pain receptors in this region. Due to this, when left untreated, inside hemorrhoids tend to become distended and get pushed beyond your rectum - causing a condition known as prolapsed or strangulated hemorrhoid.

## Fixative Procedures Include Rubber Band Ligation, Lasers or Heat

During rubber band ligation, a doctor ties small rubber bands around the base of the affected areas to be able to cut off circulation. Due to lack of blood supply, the hemorrhoids fall off in a few days after treatment. Following a method there is usually a few blood loss and discomfort for about four days. Coagulation uses laserlight or heat to shore up and shrink the hemorrhoids. Coagulation has a higher percentage of re-occurrence than rubber band ligation.

## Constipation is the Most Common Cause of Hemorrhoids

Reducing constipation addresses the root of the problem and is the most important aspect of remedy. Drinking plenty of water and eating a fiber rich diet of berry of vegetables will alleviate constipation. Soluble fiber also softens the stools, reducing pain and bleeding of hemorrhoids. For more stubborn constipation, taking a natural fiber supplement, such as psyllum husk powder, is a brilliant addition.
